





PREVECAN: AN APP TO EVALUATE ADHERENCE TO RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CANCER PREVENTION

A research group from CIBER, ISCIII and University of Alcalá de Henares has developed a software to provide Spanish population with useful information about cancer prevention.

The Need

The World Cancer Research Fund (WCRF) provides information on cancer awareness through periodic reports and through a website that contains advice and data about association between lifestyle habits and cancer risk, including a web tool that measures the degree of adherence to the recommendations for cancer prevention. However, all this information is available only in English and scattered between different reports and places on their website.

The Solution

A simple survey integrated into an app. Through consecutive screens. participant is asked questions, and their answers are scored. According to them, advice is given. The final document can be downloaded.

Innovative Aspects

- The PREVECAN app extends access to this information to non-English speakers who speak and/or understand
- It collects in a single app all the available data regarding recommendations and their compliance.
- It gives advice to improve adherence to them and brief information about the scientific knowledge linking lifestyle habits and cancer risk.
